

Public Speaking Workshop with Professor John Daly





Every speaker has a point. That was Professor John Daly's opening line at Academic's Public Speaking Workshop. John Daly is a Liddell Centennial Professor of Communication, University Distinguished Teaching Professor, TCB Professor of Management, and an Adjunct Professor of Pharmacy. He has published more than one hundred articles and chapters in scholarly publications, as well as completed six books. Dr. Daly's interests focus on practical ways of improving the communication skills of an individual.

The Public Speaking Workshop was flooded with ABSA members as well as students from BA324. "We don't make students liberal; we make them apathetic." Daly stressed that people should have the competency to answer questions and have objections to be successful. You have to be good at following up when extending an argument, and he advised to annunciate every word to make them truly count. Dr. Daly had a few tips on how to improve in presentations.

- 1. Redundancy: Say what you need to say in a different way and provide multiple forms of media. The more visual, the more the message is repeated and reinforced to make effective communication.
- 2. Become a storyteller. A great teacher knows how to tell a narrative and that we live in a tactile world. We are stories and the definition of "family" is simply a collection of stories. Stories define the family and are universal throughout any culture, despite grammar or language. Stories have points, are told quickly, and any good story can be identifiable with a value reflected in it.
- 3. Give examples. Tell a factoid, in order to be persuasive and make an input.

Overall, Dr. Daly's workshop was interesting, funny, and nevertheless very articulate.

On April 11, ABSA had the pleasure of welcoming Dell Senior VP Lawrence Tu to talk about his experiences. The workshop organized by Workshop Director Jason Watt and focused on career management, but also explored various other topics such as adapting to working abroad and moving up in a workplace.

Mr. Tu was not only an impressive speaker, but a man of varied experiences. Throughout his life Mr. Tu worked for several reputable firms over a wide range of industries before finally settling into place with Dell. He began his career as a law clerk for the U.S. Supreme Court under Justice Thurgood Marshall, and then explored various opportunities with firms such as Goldman Sachs and NBC Universal. His experiences allowed him to work in various places across the world; he traveled from Washington, D.C. to Hong Kong to New York before calling Round Rock, Texas home.

With so many worldly experiences, Mr. Tu did not disappoint with the insight he provided for the workshop attendees. A key takeaway from his presentation was that one's school or major does not define who he or she is or personal success; one's actions does. Despite the fact that he had not any prior experience for some of the positions he filled (NBC Universal in particular), Mr. Tu succeeded because he worked hard to improve and made sure people noticed. A main way he did this was by asking questions, something that he noted that Asian-Americans were often hesitant to do. Daniel Park wisely told us to be conscious of our bosses' responsibilities because one day they might be our own. The workshop closed with an open discussion between mentors, mentees, and the executive directors on how to improve the program for next year. Thank you, everyone, for participating!



On April 21, ABSA co-hosted the 3-2-1 Case Competition with ALPFA. Case competitions are not only a really great way to develop one's presentation and professional skills, but also a way to earn money. This year's version of AB-SA's annual case competition brought 12 teams together and pitted them against each other for a grand prize of \$3,000! GM, a prominent sponsor of ABSA, provided this year's case: from the standpoint of a third-party startup firm, how we can create urban mobility solutions to use in Brazil and abroad? The case competition gave competitors one week to brainstorm solutions to the case, develop financial analyses, and ultimately create presentations to present to the judges. The judging panel consisted not only of GM representatives from GM but also reps from First Investors Corporation, Deloitte Consulting, Dell, Adlucent, Cardinal Health, Duff and Phelps, as well three of our very own UT professors.

On the day of the competition, the presentations started early in the morning. Volunteers got up as early as 5:30 a.m. and many competitors did not sleep as they prepared to compete for a piece of the prize pool of \$6,000. The competitors presented a wide array of creative solutions for the case, ranging from the creation of a mobile application to the implementation of RFID at bus stations to the development of car-sharing programs. In the end, three teams came out on top: Nexus Solutions, Arbitrage Capital Group, and Aiur Innovations. Nexus Solutions, comprised of Forrest Wilkinson, John Connell, Danny An and Cameron Mena, wowed the judges with their solution of using RFID to create an IT ecosystem, taking home first place, \$3,000, and glory. For their efforts, all competitors received a t-shirt, a delicious lunch, and the experience of participating in a highly intensive case competition!



First of all this was one of the greatest and most interesting workshops I have had went to in ABSA. This workshop was with the great Andrew Ma, who is an ABSA Alumni from over 20 years back. Basically Andrew came and told us about the realities of "Life after graduating College" and made all of us think of the realities of the work life, relationships, having kids, and marriage. He also put into perceptive on how much money we spend and the importance of having a budget. He first took Terence's salary and then started factoring all of the outflows of money. He then made sure to account for the expenses we incur but our parents pay for them. All the various factors he presents really made me think about decisions and plans I had and whether the plans are financially possible. Overall the workshop did provide me a real base to start thinking about my plans (financially) after I graduate college.

Well, Professor Jue came out and gave ABSA members an intriguing roundtable discussion on April 29. Thus, Professor Jue structured her class to talk about ethics because ethics is by far the most important part of law. Law is decided by the people - what people think is morally right and wrong. Just as business is run by the people, for the people, we must remember that law is also decided and interpreted by the people.


HBSH BIRTHDHY


